
How do I make cards for confirmation and communion?

There are countless ways to create cards. We will focus on some basic materials that allow you to create many designs and expand upon them with your own ideas.

Start with Card Blanks

You can cut cards yourself, but especially for invitations or thank you cards, card blanks are very helpful. This way, you can efficiently make several cards at once. Many card blanks come with matching envelopes—our white card set is especially popular. This simple set provides an excellent foundation for creating

confirmation or communion cards. On this neutral background, you can easily stamp, paint, and glue. Consider beforehand what color scheme fits your card, since confirmation and communion cards are traditionally kept soft and suitable for the festive occasion. At the same time, they should appear cheerful and festive.



Elements and Decorations for Card Design

Papers for Card Design

Paper can be used in many ways, whether it's colored paper, photo card, or cardstock. It works great as a base or decorative element. Papers can be embossed or punched, creating impressive 3D effects. Try out a motif cardstock assortment "Confirmation". Alternatively, scrapbooking sets and paper pad sets provide suitable materials. For a general congratulatory card, a universal set is more practical than specialized paper.



Congratulations, personal dedications, and Bible verses give your card a personal touch. You can write them in directly with beautiful handwriting. Alternatively, print your texts on special paper that is suitable for printers. A tip: try printing on <u>rice paper</u> or <u>transparent paper</u>.

Stamping Techniques for Confirmation and Communion Cards

Stamping allows for a variety of motifs and techniques. Working with acrylic stamps is particularly pleasant, as the transparent material allows you to easily determine the position of the motif. Universal motifs like flowers, borders, or text banners work perfectly as well. An example is the <u>wood stamp "Our Father"</u>.





Punching and Embossing for Confirmation or Communion

Use <u>punches</u> for interesting effects. Also, <u>embossing and die-cutting machines</u> help to create professional cards.



Small Accessories for Unique Card Design

Accessories like <u>ribbons and bows</u> give your card that special touch. Use <u>small fish</u> or other small decorative elements for your card design for confirmation or communion.
