Jewellery with Pouring

Instructions No. 1994


Difficulty: Beginner

Working time: 50 Minutes

These gorgeous jewellery pieces are homemade! With only little effort and material you too can create great pieces of jewellery. Turn simple wooden rings, balls or other handicraft materials into real treasures. These are also very suitable as a gift for your loved ones.







No matter which piece of jewellery you choose, the pouring colour **for jewellery is** layered one after the other **in** a container, like a cup, and lightly stirred with a bamboo stick. Now dip the **jewellery or wooden parts** into the paint. Then hang the jewellery up to dry

Once all wooden parts are dry, attach them either to **leather straps**, stripes or **Ear hole hooks** for earrings. Another possibility is to design and combine several different wooden pieces with pouring colours.
