Working time: 6 Hours

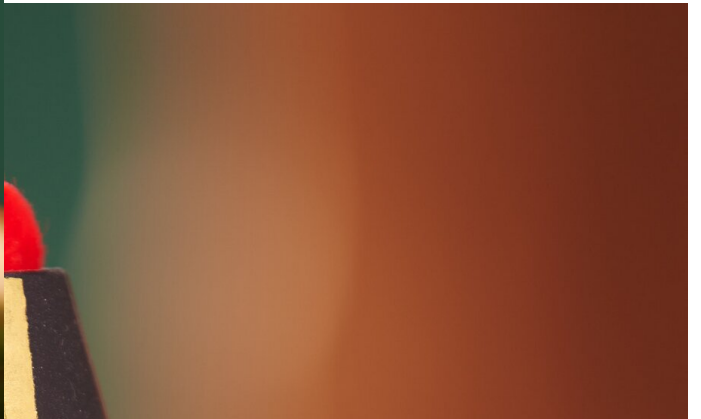
