Spice Boards & Grill Herbs in a Jar

In this tutorial we show you a great **serving board** with handle for salt and pepper and other spices. The board is an eyecatcher on your table because of the slogan that has been designed with the branding pen. You have everything ready to hand and amaze your guests with a completely different way of **serving spices**!



This is how the spice boards and herb jars are made:



Spice boards:

- 1. Print out the template or draw your desired saying or pattern on the wooden board with a pencil.
- 2. Using graphite paper, transfer the template onto the wooden board.
- Screw a tip into the Branding Pen, allow to heat up and slowly trace the lines.
- 4. Cover the handle with masking tape up to where you want to colour it. Then add accents with craft paint.

Grill spices in a jar:

- $1. \ \ \text{First clean the bottles so that they are free of grease and dust}.$
- $2. \ \ Write on the labels with a micron marker and stick them on the bottles.$
- 3. Stick some double-sided tape to the bottle and wrap jute cord around it.
