

# Tea lights with 3D motifs from structure paste

## Magical winter decorations: design your own Christmas tree tea light jars

### Step 1: Create 3D structures with the cream paste

Start your project by pouring the **cream paste** into a suitable silicone mould using a palette knife. Then leave the paste to air dry for around 12 hours to give it a firm shape. As soon as the Time to dry: is complete, carefully

remove the paste from the mold. It is advisable to clean the edges thoroughly with tweezers to achieve a clean result.

## **Step 2: Adding colorful accents**

To color your cream paste as desired, pour a small amount of the paste into a mini cup.

Then add your desired **VBS colour concentrate** and stir the mixture thoroughly until the color is evenly distributed. Once you have worked the color into the paste, close the cup with a lid. This will prevent the remaining paste from drying out and you can use it again later.

## **Step 3: Effective design with frosteffect paint**

Now take a **stippling brush** and apply the **VBS Frost-effect paint** to the tea light jars. Then leave the paint to dry completely. The frosty surface gives the glasses a wintry look and enhances the atmospheric play of lights on the candles.

## **Step 4: Attach the Christmas trees**

Glue the prepared Christmas trees to the jars with **VBS handicraft glue** to the jars. A practical tip: use rubber bands to hold the Christmas trees in place during the Time to dry: process Position hold them in place. This way you don't have to hold them in place for long and still achieve a firm result.

## **Step 5: Fill with candle sand**

Once the glue has dried, fill the jars with **candle sand**. It's very simple: fill the jar to the desired height with the granules and cut the wick to the right length. Then carefully place the wick in the granules and light it - and your Christmas tree-glass for tea lights will glow in warm candlelight.

## **Step 6: Present the jars in style**

Take two **tree slices** and glue them on top of each other in a staggered pattern. Once the glue has dried, you can place your tealight jars on top. For an extra touch of winter sparkle, sprinkle some **diamond snow around the glasses. This presentation gives your decoration an elegant, natural touch.**
