





### Quality:

Funny uni (Gründl) 100 % polyester 100 g / 120 m

Size: 98/104 - 110/116 (approx. 3 - 5 years old)

Required quantity: approx. 300 g col. 06 (pastel pink)

Needle thickness: circular knitting needle 5.0 - 6.0, crochet needle 5.0 - 6.0

#### Pattern:

<u>Stockinette stitch:</u> rsr: ri st, wsr: le st <u>Edge stitch:</u> sl. ri at the start of the row, k ri at the end of the row

#### Tension sample:

11 st x 20 r = 10 cm x 10 cm

#### Pattern:

The poncho is knitted in one piece. Begin with the back. Cast on 20 st and 2 est, start with a wsr and k in Stockinette stitch, in the process incr. 1 st 14 x i. e. rsr on each right and left working edge (= knit 1 st ri twisted from the st after the est at the start of the row and 1 st ri from the st before the est at the end of the row) (= 50 st). At a total height of 32 cm (= 64 r), c off the middle 20 st in the following wsr for the neckline and then cast on 20 st over the cast-off st in the next row. At a total height of 50 cm (= 99 r), decr. 14 x 1 st on each right and left working edge in the wsr (= c off 1 st ri after the est at the start of the row, k 1 st ri, then pull the slipped st over this and k tog. both the st before the est ri at the end of the row) (= 22 st). Then c off the st straight.

For the hood, cast on 46 st and 2 est, begin with a wsr and k 25 cm (= 50 r) in Stockinette stitch. Then c off the st straight. Fold the cast-off edge to the half and close the upper hood seam flat. Sew the cast-on edge to the neckline, in the process leave the middle 12 cm of the front neckline free (see section sketch) and gently hold the hood during the sewing. <u>Completion:</u>

Crochet the entire poncho with loops as follows: in the process crochet together the front and back side at the end of the side-on slants (= armholes).

1st rd.: 1 sl st, 1 ch and 1 scr in the 1st st of the lower edge, \* pull the st on the needle to an approx. 3 cm long loop, crochet 1 ch and 1 scr with equally elongated working thread into this loop, elongate the st on then needle again, 1 scr with elongated working thread in the st after next of the poncho edge, work another scr into the same st, from \* continually rep., fasten the last loop with 1 sl st to the ch of the start of the round

2nd rd.: 1 sl st, 1 ch and 1 scr in the scr of the tip of the 1st loop of the previous rd., \* pull the st on the needle to an approx. 3 cm long loop, elongate the working thread in the same manner and crochet 4 ch and 1 scr into this loop, elongate the st on the needle again, crochet 1 scr with elongated working thread into the scr of the tip of the following loop of the previous rd., work another 1 scr into the same st, from \* continually rep., fasten the last loop with 1 sl st to the ch of the start of the round
