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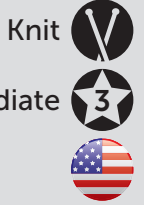

SIZE

approx. 45 x 200 cm

MATERIALS

Schachenmayr Corsica, 50 g ball

approx. 50 g = 120 m

Col. 00089 (ocean color)

2 balls

Schachenmayr Catania, 50 g ball

approx. 50 g = 125 m

Col. 00164 (jeans)

2 balls

Col. 00427 (scampi)

1 ball

Col. 00394 (burgund)

2 balls

Col. 00391 (petrol)

3 balls

Schachenmayr Summer Shine, 50 g ball

approx. 50 g = 145 m

Col. 00190 (silver)

1 ball

Yarn amounts are approximate. Make sure to purchase enough of the same dye lot in order to complete your project. The colour names refer to the German names on the sleeves. The amount of yarn needed can vary from person to person.

1 circular needle 4.0 mm, 80 cm long

1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

BASIC PATTERN

Garner stitch:

RS and WS: knit all st.

Lace pattern:

Work according to Pattern Chart A in rows.

Read the RS rows from right to left. For the WS rows (not shown), work all st from the RS as described in the key to the symbols, reading from left to right.

Begin with the 11 st before the pattern repeat; then repeat the 14 st of the pattern repeat until 12 st before the end and end with the 12 st after the pattern repeat.

Repeat Rows 1 through 20 for pattern.

Textured pattern:

Work according to Pattern Chart B in rows.

Read the RS rows from right to left. For the WS rows (not shown), work all st from the RS as described in the key to the symbols, reading from left to right.

Begin with the 11 st before the pattern repeat; then repeat the 14 st of the pattern repeat until 12 st before the end and end with the 12 st after the pattern repeat.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 for pattern.

Skp: slip 1 st as if to knit, k1, pass the slipped stitch over the knitted stitch.

Sk2p: slip 2 st as if to knit, k1, pass the 2 slipped stitches over the knitted stitch.

Stripe Sequence A: * work 10 R in Burgundy, 10 R in Jeans, 10 R in Scampi and 10 R in Jeans;

repeat from * 2x more, end with 10 R Burgundy.

Stripe Sequence B: * work 2 R in Silver and 10 R in Petrol, repeat from * 13x more, end with 2 R Silver.

Gauge

Garner stitch: 24 st and 42 rows = 10 x 10 cm

Lace pattern: 24 st and 26 rows = 10 x 10 cm.

Textured pattern: 24 st and 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm.

Adjust your needle size if necessary to obtain the correct gauge.

INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 107 st in Ocean and work in garner st in rows, beginning with a WS row.

When you have worked 61 R in garner st, continue working in the lace pattern, following Stripe Sequence A.

When you have worked 130 R in the lace pattern, continue working in the textured pattern, following Stripe Sequence B.

When you have worked 170 R in the textured pattern, continue working in the lace pattern, following Stripe Sequence A.

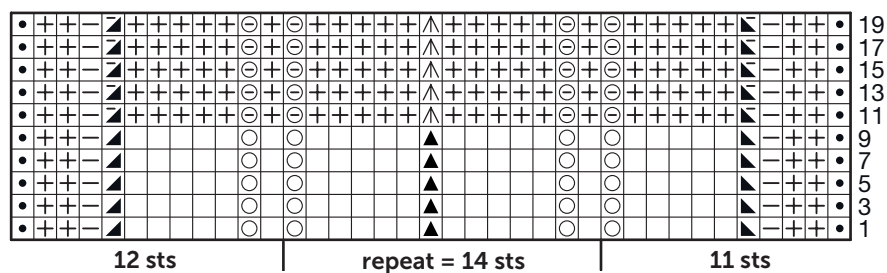
After 130 R in the lace pattern, change to Ocean and work in garner st for 62 R. Bind off all st.

FINISHING

Dampen and block the shawl; allow to dry.

Use the tapestry needle to weave in all loose threads within their respective color areas.

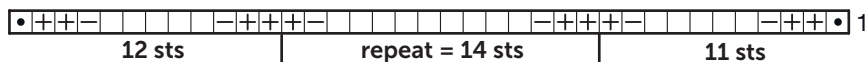
