KNOTS USED

Lark knot
Square knot

BEFORE STARTING

8 x 1.30 m of rope (6 of the main colour and 2 of the contrasting colour)
1 x 40 cm of rope (contrasting colour)
16 x 12 cm of rope (main colour)

STEP BY STEP:

STEP 1: Fix the 40 cm rope with masking tape on the work surface.



STEP 2: Using a **lark knot**, place the 8 pieces of rope (1.30m) folded in half on the upper rope.



STEP 3: With each group of 4 ropes, make a **square knot** approximately 6 cm under the upper rope. Make 4 square knots in this first row.



STEP 4: For the second row, leaving 2 ropes on the right and 2 ropes on the left free, make groups of 4 ropes again to make square knots. This row has 3 square knots.




STEP 5: Alternate rows of 4 square knots (like the first row) with rows of 3 square knots (like the second row) until there are 9 rows.



STEP 6: Add the 12 cm ropes on the sides. In the loop of each even row include two of these ropes using a lark knot.



STEP 7: Remove the upper rope and cut them.



STEP 8: Unravel the rope's ends and with the help of the comb brush them.



WASHING ADVICE

Always wash in as warm a water temperature as possible - up to the temperature recommended, with a short spin. Use a lot of water if hand washing. For darker colours we recommend the use of discolouration sheets.

Do not bleach.

Do not tumble dry. Drip-dry on a horizontal surface.

Iron on a hot temperature setting using a damp cloth.

Professional dry cleaning in tetrachloroethylene.
