Poose Crochet Bags

Design: Schachenmayr Designteam





SIZE

A Bag with pale green: about 17 cm wide, 28 cm high.B Bag with jade: about 22 cm wide, 30 cm high.C Bag with regatta: about 27 cm wide, 34 cm high.

MATERIALS

Schachenmayr Catania, 50 g balls

approx. 50 g \approx 125 m

A col 00392 (gelbgrün)3 ballsB col 00253 (jade)4 ballsC col 00261 (regatta)5 balls

Yarn amounts are approximate. Make sure to purchase enough of the same dye lot in order to complete your project.

1 Crochet hook 4.0 mm und 5.0 mm

TENSION

With 4.0 mm hook and Basic Pattern 26 textured dc and 14 rows, each to 10 cm.

Take time to check your tension. If you have too many stitches and rows, switch to larger needles. If you have too few stitches and rows, switch to smaller needles.

THE BASICS

Textured dc from front: yo, then insert hook from front to back into the dc or textured dc of prev row, fetch thread through and crochet 1 dc.

Textured dc from back: proceed as for the textured dc from the front, but to fetch thread through insert hook from back to front through the dc or textured dc.

Basic pattern: odd no of sts. Textured dc. To cast on crochet an even no of ch. **Row 1:** dc, working 1st dc into 4th ch from

the hook.

Row 2: 2 ch, \bigstar 1 textured dc from the front, 1 textured dc from the back, rep from \bigstar , end with 1 textured dc from the front

Row 3: 2 ch, \star 1 textured dc from the back, 1 textured dc from the front, rep from \star , end with 1 textured dc from the back.

Rep rows 2-3 throughout for patt.

INSTRUCTIONS

A Bag with pale green: with 4.0 mm hook crochet 46 ch and work 56cm Basic patt.

B Bag with jade: with 4.0 mm hook crochet

60 ch and work 60cm Basic patt. **C Bag with regatta:** with 4mm hook crochet 72 ch and work 68cm Basic patt.

FINISHING OFF

Fold each bag in half (RS facing) and crochet the upper half of side edges tog with the double thread and crochet hook size 5.0 mm and sc, then turn bag and crochet lower half of side edges tog. At the end crochet 1 row crab stitch (= sc from left to right), at the end of the lower half cut thread long enough, fetch through to inside, turn bag and continue to crochet. After the last crab stitch crochet 1 sl-st, cut thread, fetch through the last st on hook and darn away. Turn upper edge of bag out.

ch = chain dc = double crochet patt = pattern rep = repeat RS = right side sc = single crochet sl-st = slip stitch st (s) = stitch (es) tog = together

yo = yarn over
